

TOUR ITINERARY

10 DAY GOLF AROUND TASMANIA

THE EXPERIENCE

- Enjoy a round or two on the Royal Hobart Golf Course, renowned for the quality of its bunkers. Play on this premier course until 3pm and then enjoy the Hobart waterfront at your own leisure.
- Sample delicious boutique wines on our Wine Tasting Tour. We visit Velo Winery, Tamar Ridge Winery, Moores Hill Winery and Holm Oak Winery, all set in the picturesque Tamar Valley.
- Experience a true golfing adventure at Barnbougle. We play 18 holes on the award-winning The Dunes. Golfers come from around the world to stroll this traditional links course. Designed to complement rather than detract from the landscape it has earned the reputation as a top public access course. Pull carts are included but motorised carts can be organised.
- Barnbougle Lost Farm has been built on steeper dunes and is an exciting and challenging course with strategic bunkering, undulating greens and wide fairways. It also boasts breathtaking views of the Forester River and Tasmanian Hinterland. We play 18 holes here. This award-winning course was voted #3 in Australia by Australian Golf Magazine, just behind The Dunes at #2.
- Spend a few hours fossicking in Tasmania's largest antique and collectibles store – Antique Emporium. You're sure to find a treasure or two to take home.
- Get the camera ready for Tasmania's mountain jewel – Cradle Mountain. This iconic mountain is located in Cradle Mountain-Lake St Claire National Park, part of the Tasmanian World Heritage Area. Here, ancient pines fringe glacial lakes and icy streams cascade down rugged mountains. The vegetation is rich and diverse including grassland, rainforest and many ancient plants such as King Billy pine. It's a hotspot for native wildlife including wombats, quolls, Tasmanian Devils and echidnas.
- Play 18 holes at Devonport Golf Club. This is one of the prettiest courses on the North West Coast.
- Hike the Wineglass Bay Hazards Beach Circuit. This stunning walk is an 11km circuit. An unforgettable experience, you will encounter the white sands and crystal-clear water of the famous Wineglass Bay before walking through grasslands to the striking Hazards Beach.
- Try a Spirit Tasting at Sullivans Cove Distillery – Sullivans Single Malt Whisky was declared the best in the world in 2014!
- Have lunch in the quaint historic village of Richmond. Walk over and under the oldest convict constructed sandstone bridge in Australia, visit the oldest Catholic Church in Australia and peruse the antique shops and galleries.
- Head underground to the weird and whacky world of Mona. This is Australia's largest private museum with three levels of underground galleries. Get ready, it's like stepping into your subconscious.
- Just 20 minutes from Hobart, pass through temperate rainforest, sub-alpine flora and glacial rock formations before reaching the summit of kunanyi/Mt Wellington with extraordinary views.
- Enjoy lunch at Bangor Vineyard Shed on the way to the Tasman Peninsula. Sample some award-winning wines while soaking in the view.

- Port Arthur Historic Site is a bucket-list destination for most visitors to Tasmania. Delve into the dark history of hardship and punishment on a guided introductory tour through the ruins and preserved buildings on the grounds.
- Enjoy a short harbour cruise around the Isle of the Dead and Point Puer, the site of the English colonies first boy's prison. This is a good opportunity to have a warm drink or sample a local wine or beer.

Day 6:

Pickup at 8.30am and travel to Devonport to Antique Emporium.

Visit Cradle Mountain. Visit Sheffield and see the town of murals.

Arrive at Devonport around 5pm.

Meals not included.

Accommodation: Barclay Motor Inn, Devonport.

Day 7:

Pickup at 8.30am to Devonport Golf Club.

Play 18 holes.

Pickup at 3pm. Return to Devonport for free time/exploration.

Meals not included.

Accommodation: Barclay Motor Inn, Devonport.

Day 8:

Pickup at 8.30am and enjoy the drive to Freycinet National Park.

Hike the spectacular 11km Wineglass Bay and Hazards Beach circuit with a packed lunch.

Arrive at Bicheno about 4.30pm.

Packed lunch included. All other meals not.

Accommodation: Bicheno By the Bay, Bicheno.

Day 9:

Spirit Tasting at Sullivans Cove Distillery.

Visit the historic town of Richmond.

Go underground at the famous Mona Museum.

Arrive back at accommodation at 4.30pm.

Meals not included.

Mantra One – Sandy Bay.

Day 10:

Head to the summit of kunanyi/Mt Wellington.

Bangor Vineyard Shed for lunch.

Port Arthur Historic Site.

Drop off at Hobart airport or CBD at 5.30pm.
